Reactants - and acid and a base Products - a salt and water Ex - $\text{HCl} + \text{NaOH} \rightarrow \text{H}_2\text{O} + \text{Na} + \text{Cl} - (\text{NaCl})$ Salt is any product made from a neutralization reaction.
