### **Four Novels Of The 1960s**

Like secular Jewish literature, Russian literature invented itself relatively late. The eighteenth-century aristocrats who sought to create a national literature in Russian faced language problems (they spoke, by preference, French) and the necessity of imitating European models.

Publishing history. The series originated with *A Wrinkle in Time*, written in 1959 to 1960 and turned down by 26 publishers before Farrar, Straus and Giroux finally published it in 1962. *A Wrinkle in Time* won the Newbery Medal and has sold over 6 million copies. The sequel, *A Wind in the Door*, takes place the following year but was published over a decade later, in 1973.
